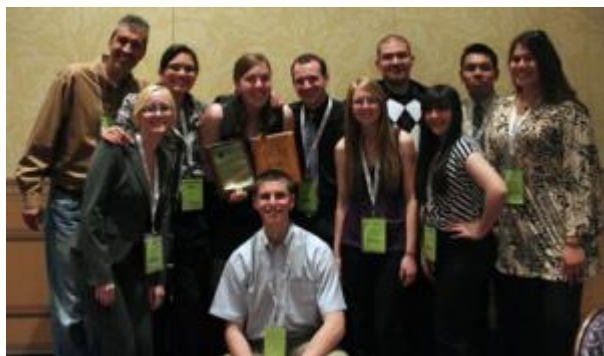


# SAACS Receives Two ACS Awards
