The Bi-annual **Victor J. Hruby Fellowship in Chemistry** was established 18 years ago. In 1993, alumni students, postdoctoral and research associates of Regent's Professor **Victor J. Hruby** established the first fellowship supporting graduate students at The University of Arizona who are engaged in the study of peptide research.

The Victor J. Hruby Fellowship in Peptide Research focuses on supporting interdisciplinary scientific research on peptides, which is a trademark of Professor Hruby's style and achievements in the area of scientific research and drug discovery.

The fellowship is given for outstanding research to graduate students who have passed their preliminary oral exams, and to postdoctoral fellows doing outstanding research in peptide science. Their performance is evaluated on the basis of their seminars, publications, and presentations at meetings. Technical skills, creativity and scientific leadership are also considered.
